New Rule Proposed to Clarify PPE Standards in Construction



Yesterday, the U.S. Department of

Labor announced a proposed rule to clarify the personal protective equipment (PPE) standard for the construction industry. The proposed change would clarify that PPE must fit each employee properly to protect them from occupational hazards. The proposed rule is available to view on the Federal Register. Interested parties may submit comments and hearing requests no later than September 18.
