North Carolina Codifies VPP

Under the leadership of Labor Commissioner Cherie Berry, North Carolina became the fifth state to codify its Voluntary Protection Program. North Carolina joins a bipartisan mix of states - Indiana, Virginia, Arizona and Maryland - in passing legislation to make voluntary compliance a permanent part of workplace safety. "Workplace safety is my passion," said Commissioner Berry, who has grown the largest state-based VPP program in the nation, with 145 worksites participating. "Codifying VPP is important because it tells business and labor that we are committed to keeping a great thing going."
